# JUDGE JOHN E. HUBER MOTION FOR MOTION FOR CLARIFICATION

COMES NOW, Steven John Donahue, Movant pro se, requesting clarification of the April 7, 2025, ruling restoring visitation effective immediately (Neb. Rev. Stat. § 30-2613, Visitation Rights). Judge Huber and Movant went back-and-forth in a productive exchange and reached an oral agreement about safe visitation with Movant's spouse, to be strictly conducted according to Prestige Care Center's Rule Book, and adhere to any other conditions Prestige feels is necessary to ensure safe visitation with Linda. Attorneys for Toto did not present written rules which they said they had previously prepared. They read pertinent rules orally, and Movant agreed with them and discussed these orally with Judge Huber. Movant believes this whole matter would have been resolved if Carol Toto had appeared as ordered and promised by her through her attorney at the February J*x*, <sup>N</sup> 2025 hearing.

These rules were then reiterated multiple times orally by Judge Huber with Movant's agreement on all items, such as no guns, no alcohol, no drugs, no homemade meals per Dr. Wester's orders, Prestige has the right to search me, I will not be involved in Physical Therapy or with Linda's doctors, I will not be rude or disruptive, I will not make any recordings, and so on. Prestige is to provide Movant with their Rule Book. If I violate any rules, then Prestige has the right to ban me. If I have an issue with such a ban, then my only recourse would be to argue or "sue"



Prestige—specifically stated "not Toto or Pallesen".

Judge Huber set June 30, 2025, for a contested hearing on all matters pending before his Court. Yet, hours after the hearing, Pallesen emailed Movant stating she was putting together a safety plan document. No such "new" rules were forthcoming. Movant intends to visit his wife on Tuesday, April 8, 2025, at 11:00 AM, bringing only Burger King and some AAA batteries his spouse needs. Pallesen and Toto are attempting a delaying tactic, ignoring Neb. Rev. Stat. § 25-914. Movant is amenable to viewing a proposed contract with Pallesen but reserves the right to review, especially if it contains items outside of "safe visitation" or outside of Prestige's bailiwick. This is important as Movant has to prepare for a Contested Hearing and seek his own counsel.

This is not complicated. Movant has visited his wife almost 400 times over the space of two-plus years. Restoring his visitation is not a safety issue under the Prestige Care Center rules, amended to include no homemade meals, per Dr. Wester's orders. Movant will adhere to his oral agreement with Judge Huber and abide by any and all Prestige concerns. I have agreed to this binding oral agreement with Judge Huber.

Movant understands that today Linda performed the cognitive test Mini-Cog, a standard test, and according to Linda (the test was administered to Linda by Erin, while she was in PT and bicycling for 20 minutes), she scored a 19—indicating mild cognitive decline. Linda has strongly voiced her desire to have her husband visit to all staff and Prestige and her sister, Carol, in Florida. Linda has left repeated messages with her sister but has not heard from her in about a week.

Linda's needs and desires will be addressed in a manner that all agree is safe.
