MOTION TO APPOINT A
SUCCESSOR GUARDIAN AND
SUCCESSOR CONSERVATOR

COMES NOW, Steven John Donahue, Movant and Spouse of the Protected Person, Linda M. Lefebvre Donahue, by and through himself, Pro Se, asks the Court for an Order to appoint him as Successor Guardian and Successor Conservator for Linda M. Lefebvre Donahue.

1. Movant, Steven John Donahue, as spouse, of Linda Lefebvre Donahue—Ward/Protected Person, with Spousal Priority under Neb. Rev. Stat. § 30-2627, is an interested party in her welfare pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 30-2619 and § 30-2633 and in these proceedings.

2. Douglas County, Nebraska is the Movant's place of residence. Broward County, Florida is the Guardian's place of residence.

3. Linda Lefebvre Donahue, for whom a Successor Guardian and Conservator is sought, and who had a debilitating stroke on March 31, 2010, and numerous medical setbacks 2021-2022, has been a resident at the Prestige Care Center in Plattsmouth, Nebraska for about 26 months. Movant has been her primary caregiver since the onset



of her 2010 stroke. This Movant and Linda's brother-in-law, Robert Donahue, have been the only visitors Linda has had during this time frame. Both Movant and Robert Donahue have been prohibited from visiting Linda by her current Guardian. No reason for this has been forthcoming.

4. Venue for this proceeding is proper in Douglas County because the above named person, Linda Lefebvre Donahue resided in Douglas County as defined as Neb. Rev. Stat § 30-2618 at the the time of the prior filings. She has never been legally separated from her spouse, Steven John Donahue since their marriage on April 6, 2009 in Hollywood, Florida. The spouses voted and filed joint tax returns in 2014 and 2015 at their residence at apartment 110 at 1511 Farnam Street, Omaha, Nebraska 68102. Attached hereto and incorporated herein, is:

- a) Exhibit 1: Marriage Certificate;
- b) Exhibit 3: District Court filing of a 2014 joint Harassment Order against a former tenant.

5. Linda Lefebvre Donahue is a 66-year-old female. She is currently a Ward/Protected Person and a Successor appointment is necessary and desirable as a means of providing her continued care with a Successor Guardianship and Conservatorship. The current Permanent Guardian and Conservator, Carol Lefebvre Toto has recently filed a motion to Withdraw. More recently, Carol Lefebvre Toto has filed another Motion to continue as Guardian and Conservator, stating in part that she "does not want an unknown person to potentially become the new Guardian." Carol Lefebvre Toto is a permanent resident of the State of Florida and has not seen her sister in many years. It is therefore necessary and prudent to have Linda's Spouse as Successor Guardian. Movant has filed a Petition for a Reconciliation Agreement that includes appointing him as Successor Guardian.

6. An emergency exists in that the above-captioned Protected Person is currently isolated and vulnerable as she is being denied all visits, Spousal visitation, Family visitation, husbandly care, delivery of homemade meals, and has had Assistive Technology removed from her room in an effort to curb outside communication. In addition, she is not getting informed, adequate and current medical care; such as, being examined by a physician, being referred to mental health therapies in order to be treated for Family/Marriage or other current issues. A specific description of the functional limitations and physical and mental condition ought to be conducted for Linda by an outside, neutral source. Linda has the ability to understand and appreciate the nature and consequences of health care decisions, and has the ability to communicate such decisions pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat § 30-3402. Movant has filed a Petition for a Reconciliation Agreement that includes provisions for obtaining Linda such a Medical Provider.

Linda, as a Protected person has the right Right to appropriate services based on her needs pursuant to § 30-2628 and other Constitutional Rights;

Right to have the Guardian take into account their desires and preferences;

Right to a safe, sanitary living environment;

Right to the least restrictive living arrangements as possible;

Right to not be discriminated against based on race, religion, creed, sex, age, marital status, sexual orientation or political affiliations;

Right to have explanations of any medical procedures or treatment;

Right to have personal information kept confidential;

Right to speak privately with an attorney, ombudsman or advocate; and

Right to petition the Court to terminate a Guardianship or to bring a grievance against a Guardian.

7. The current Guardian, Carol Lefebvre Toto, stated in her Motion to Resign that a Successor Guardian is necessary because of a breakdown in the relationship with the Protected Person and her Spouse. Carol Lefebvre Toto has filed another Motion to continue as Guardian and Conservator, stating in part that she "does not want an unknown person to potentially become the Successor Guardian." The current Guardian has stated during a recent three-way call between Kathleen Pallesen, esq., and Kelly Henry Turner, esq. that "It is never going to happen" referring to re-establishing fruitful communications between Movant and sister-in-law. This Movant has filed a Petition for a Reconciliation Agreement that includes Proposing Communication methods between the Guardian and Petitioner.

8. Linda Lefebvre Donahue has expressed her wish that her Spouse be appointed as her Successor Guardian/Conservator. She is concerned that her sister is in Florida, has reported poor health, has difficulty in contacting her sister, and that they have not seen each other in years and are essentially strangers. It is essential that Linda has a Successor Guardian, for these and other reasons. Linda understands that a Petition for a Reconciliation Agreement has been filed with the Court to address some of her concerns.

9. No other suitable Successor Guardian is available save for Linda's spouse, Steven John Donahue. Movant has completed the Public Guardian's training curricula pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 30-2601.01, and other requirements.

10. The prohibition of Spousal visitation has placed Linda Lefebvre Donahue under extreme, unexplained, and unnecessary stress.

She still needs help or lacks sufficient understanding or ability or consistent focus to make or communicate responsible decisions in some of the following areas:

- (a) Selecting her place of abode within The State of Nebraska;
- (b) Arranging for some of her treatment or medical care;
- (c) Protecting her personal effects;
- (d) Giving some necessary consents, approvals, or releases;
- (e) Arranging for training, education, or other rehabilitative services that are appropriate to her circumstances;
- (f) Applying for governmental or private benefits for which she may be entitled;
- (g) Instituting proceedings to compel any person liable for her support to support her;
- (h) Entering into any contractual agreements;
- (i) Receiving money and tangible property deliverable to her, and applying such money and applying such money or property to her expenses for room, board, treatment, medical care, personal care, personal effects, training, education, and rehabilitative services.

14. No other less restrictive measures have been attempted, contemplated, or discussed with the Protected Person or her Spouse by the present Guardian. Linda has been prevented from attending Catholic Mass along with other residents, renewing her Nebraska State I.D., which has expired, and had no help in registering to vote.

12. No Guardian or Conservator has been appointed by Will. This Court has previously issued Letters of Guardianship to Carol Lefebvre Toto.

13. Movant claims Spousal Priority pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 30-2627. This Movant has nominated himself. Steven John Donahue, whose address is 1511 Farnam Street, Apt. 110, Omaha, Nebraska 68102, who is a competent, suitable, and proper person to be appointed as Successor Guardian and Conservator for his spouse, Linda Lefebvre Donahue.
